

Important Information for District 5300 SuperBuild on May 6, 2017

Are you ready for an exciting day in Mexico?! Please read this important information to help ensure a successful build day!

1. **Transportation:** The long wait lines and unfamiliar roads can be initially overwhelming, and damper the fun of the day, so to prevent this from happening, we have chartered buses for each of the builds this year! Buses ensure easy and quick passage across the border (an express lane is available for buses) and makes sure that everyone stays together and gets to the correct build site! *Please bring \$25 to cover the cost of your seat on the bus.* Because of the bus rentals provided, we will not have anybody drive personal vehicles on this trip.
2. **Water & Snacks:** Feel free to bring a small personal cooler with drinks and snacks for the day! The days can be hot, and we want to be sure everyone stays hydrated and energized! Remember that since we are taking a bus, you have to be able to take off and carry all your belongings off the bus at the border crossing so they can check the bus. Be sure the size is manageable for you to carry. Nothing more than what you can personally carry.
3. **Meeting Time & Location:** **We will be meeting at 6:00am in the Terra Nova Plaza located at 360 East H Street, Chula Vista, CA 91910.** The Corazón Saturday Supervisor will give a brief rundown of the day as well as directions for the crossing, and then we will begin loading the buses in front of the **Smart and Final**. Please be on time as it is imperative we leave on time from that location.
4. **What to Bring:** Please follow the “Before you Go checklist” in The Saturday Bulletin. This will give you a rundown of information of things to bring to your build. *Please note that bringing your own tools will increase your involvement greatly as Corazón has limited supplies. A tool belt or nail apron, tape measure, hammer, pencil, gloves, paint rollers,*

*paint pans, etc., all help during that day! A **passport**, a hat, sunscreen, close-toed shoes, and snacks, are also imperative for your build day. Remember your **passport!***

5. **Sign-Up:** Please follow the Volunteer Profile and Project Registration instruction. If you are planning on joining us on the build day- please be sure you are signed up! For safety and logistical reasons, it is very important that we know who is joining us, so we can plan for you and be sure you have a great day with us!

I would like to thank each and every one of you for joining us! Please take your experience back to your clubs and share when we are through. Your promotion and insight to the experience is vital to the Superbuild success. SuperBuild needs the support of many clubs, not a few, in order to succeed.
