

Important Information for District 5300 SuperBuild on June 2, 2018

Are you ready for an exciting day in Mexico?! Please read this important information to help ensure a successful build day!

1. **Transportation:** We use a caravan style of transportation from our meeting place in Otay Mesa to the respective build sites. **Please make certain that if you're driving, you have the appropriate vehicle insurance. This is very important!**
2. **Water & Snacks:** Feel free to bring a small personal cooler with drinks and snacks for the day! The days can be hot, and we want to be sure everyone stays hydrated and energized!
3. **Meeting Time & Location:** We will be meeting at 7:00am at the **McDonalds in Otay Mesa, CA. located at: 2320 Roll Dr, San Diego, CA 92154.** The Project Mercy Saturday Supervisor will give a brief rundown of the day as well as directions for the crossing, and then we will begin loading the personal vehicles lined up for a caravan to the build sites. Please be on time as it is imperative we leave on time from that location.
4. **What to Bring:** Please note that bringing your own tools will increase your involvement greatly as Project Mercy has limited supplies. A tool belt or nail apron, tape measure, hammer, pencil, gloves, paint rollers, paint pans, etc., all help during that day! A passport, a hat, sunscreen, close-toed shoes, and snacks, are also imperative for your build day. Remember your passport!
5. **Sign-Up:** Please follow the Volunteer Profile and Project Registration instruction. If you are planning on joining us on the build day- please be sure you are signed up! For safety and logistical reasons, it is very important that we know who is joining us, so we can plan for you and be sure you have a great day with us! Registration is simply executed in dacdb.
