After you Log in, Click on the District tab in the blue navigation bar. Once on the district page, click on the icon labeled "Calendar". This will take you to a list of events. Find the event titled "District Conference 2019"

- Remember your password to Log in to the District Data Base. If this is your first-time logging into the District Data Base, use your email address as your User Name, and your Rotary Member ID # as your password. Your Rotary Member ID # is located in the upper left-hand corner of the label on your Rotarian Magazine. If you have previously signed on, and have forgotten your password, click the "Forgotten Password" Line for help.

**Q: WHEN SHOULD I REGISTER?**

- On-line registration is now open
- Early bird registration for meal packages is \$230 per registrant through October 31, 2018. Beginning November 1, 2018 and continuing through December 31, 2018, the meal package rate increases to \$240.00 per registrant. January 1, 2019 – Date of Conference, the rate increases to \$255.00 per registrant. A La Carte options are also available.

**Q: HOW DO I ARRANGE ACCOMMODATIONS?**

- Make room reservations directly with the hotel using the code provided on the district website. Cut-off date for hotel is April 15, 2019 to secure guaranteed rate of \$169.00 per night.
