Day 1 Wed June 03: Flight to Island of Maui

Embark on your flight to Paradise today!

On arrival you'll be transferred to your hotel the Sheraton Maui- fancy but casual, located on 23 lush oceanfront acres on legendary Ka'anapali Beach.
