All entries submitted up to 11" X 14" (landscape or portrait) accepted with thickness not to exceed ¼ inch. Art will be digitally displayed at the Oct. 24, 2020 District 5300 Peace held via Zoom on Saturday, October 24, from 9:00 am - 12:15 pm.

- Media Choices: oil, pastel, charcoal, graphite, pen and ink, watercolor, marker, mixed media or photography
- Students may submit more than one entry.
- Names placed on the front of submitted artwork will be disqualified
- Entries becomes the property of Rotary International and will not be returned to the artist, so take a photo of yourself with your artwork prior to submission.
- All entries must incorporate a Rotary International or Rotary Interact symbol or logo within the artwork.
