**Entry Details**

- Your art will represent your thoughts on the 2023 theme, “Peace Through Service”
- Art must be no larger than 11” X 14” (landscape or portrait)
- Art canvas thickness should not exceed ¼ inch.
- All entries **must incorporate** a Rotary International or Rotary Interact symbol or logo clearly visible within the artwork. Google “Interact” or “Rotary International” for logo examples.
- Media Choices: oil, pastel, charcoal, graphite, pen and ink, watercolor, marker, mixed media, graphic design, or photography
- Students may submit one entry per media choice.
- Submitted artworks with names placed on the front of artwork will be disqualified.
- Winning selections will be displayed March 18, 2023 at the Rotary District 5300 Peace Conference held at the Richard Nixon Library in Yorba Linda, CA from 8:00 AM – Noon and on the Rotary District 5300 and 5330 Web pages: [www.district5300.org](http://www.district5300.org) and [www.district5330.org](http://www.district5330.org).
- Entries become the property of Rotary International and will not be returned to the artist, so take a photo of yourself with your artwork prior to submission.
